

Photography Competition Call for entries

You are invited to participate in the London Restaurant Festival 2011 photography competition with a chance to have your work published in the new London Evening Standard Food magazine. The search is on for three photographers who have an interest in restaurants, events and food. We are looking for applicants who will best portray the celebratory atmosphere surrounding this annual citywide event.

The Task

To narrate the story of the two-week festival running from 3-17 October with engaging images of restaurants and chefs across our dozens of events including Suppliers Markets and VIP dinners on the London Eye.

To Enter

Submit 5 examples of your work portraying people at un-staged social events and/or food related images to info@londonrestaurantfestival.com

Closing date for entries, 31 August 2011.

Prizes

The three shortlisted photographers will get the chance to photograph Michelin star chefs in their working environments and at iconic venues around London during the festival. There will also be the chance to eat at some of London's leading restaurants. Images produced by all three winners will feature on our website and in all press and marketing material. The winning image taken of the festival will be published in the December issue of the new London Evening Standard Food magazine - a free magazine with a circulation c.200,000.

Judging

London restaurant festival founders Fay Maschler and Simon Davis will select three winners from all the entries submitted. They will also choose a winning image taken during the festival that will feature in London's Evening Standard Food magazine.

On working days we will not require you to work for the whole day, most events would only require you to work for a couple of hours.
